The goal of the International Conference on Performance Engineering (ICPE) is to provide a forum for the collaboration of knowledge in performance engineering of software and systems, including ideas, methods, and results. ICPE also shares experience from performance measurement, modeling, benchmark design, and runtime performance management.

ICPE is sponsored by ACM SIGMETRICS, ACM SIGSOFT, and SPEC, and is co-located with the regular SPEC group meetings, where work on the latest industry standard benchmarks such as SPECvirt_sc is coordinated. As a conference, ICPE has grown out of the ACM Workshop on Software and Performance (WOSP) and the SPEC International Performance Evaluation Workshop (SIPEW). WOSP has traditionally brought together software engineers, developers, performance analysts, and performance modelers, who are addressing the many challenges of developing, modeling, and measuring scalable high performance software. SIPEW was established with the goal of bridging the gap between theory and practice in the field of system performance evaluation by providing a forum for sharing knowledge between industry and academia.

This unique background provides the ICPE conference with both industrial and academic roots, attracting researchers as well as industry practitioners. The emphasis on cooperation is also reflected in the conference by accepting not only research papers, but also industrial papers, works in progress and demo submissions – all categories with its respective rules and expert review process.
